



The above plat represents a tract of land belonging to Dr. W. A. Mooney and is situated in Greenville County South Carolina and as represented lies on both sides of South Pacolet River. The whole tract contains four hundred and sixty-seven and 35/100 acres. The lines marked "A" were surveyed by me in June 28th 1903, the other lines were taken from old deeds and plats, therefore the magnetic variation is not certain. That part of the plat was taken from other work the streams may not all be represented and those that are represented may not be exactly correct. That part of the plat colored blue represents a tract deeded by James W. Martin to Dr. W. A. Mooney and dated 1852. The small piece on the north side and colored green represent a lot deeded to Dr. W. A. Mooney from Earle. The line S. 66° 1/2 E. 16.15 was not surveyed only calculated from old work. The small piece on the south side and colored blue represents a lot deeded in 1903 to Dr. W. Mooney. The Reid, M. E. Johnson, S. Campbell & Co. Recorded March 26-1912 M. E. Johnson, S.
