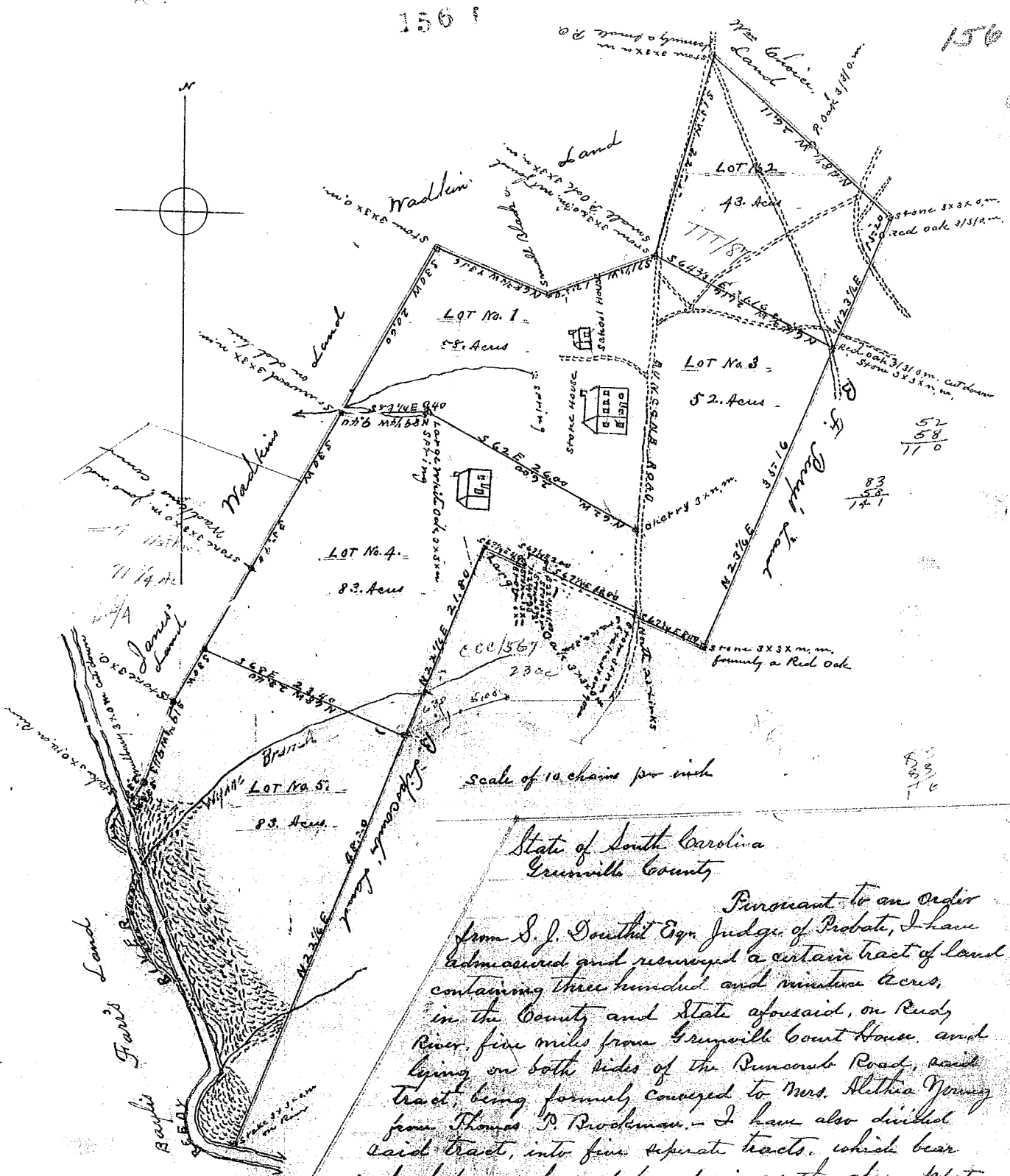

Pursuant to an order from S. J. Douthett Esq. Judge of Probate, I have administered and resumed a certain tract of land containing three hundred and nineteen acres, in the County and State aforesaid, on Ruddy River, five miles from Greenville Court House, and lying on both sides of the Rumcorn Road, said tract, being formerly conveyed to Mrs. Althea Young from Thomas P. Rockman. I have also divided said tract, into five separate tracts, which bear such shape, marks and boundaries as the above plat represents.
