P E T I T I O N

The Petitioners Cecil Ray Moore and Phyllis Vivian Moore did heretofore on or about the eleventh day of June, 1973, purchase a certain piece of property from one J. Z. Rearden, which deed was recorded on the twenty-first day of June, 1973, in Deed Book 977 at Page 318, and the said Cecil Ray Moore and Phyllis Vivian Moore did pay the sum of Three Thousand Five Hundred and No/100 (\$3,500.00) Dollars for the property - One Thousand Eight Hundred and No/100 (\$1,800.00) Dollars of which was paid in cash and the balance by way of a purchase money note and mortgage for One Thousand Seven Hundred and No/100 (\$1,700.00) Dollars, which mortgage is dated the eighteenth day of June, 1973, and recorded on the twenty-first day of June, 1973, in Mortgage Book 1282 at Page 324.

That the said J. Z. Rearden died intestate in Greenville County and left surviving him his Widow, one of the Petitioners herein, and no children. There has been no administration of the estate and the Petitioners Cecil Ray Moore and Phyllis Vivian Moore have made all of the payments as provided for in the mortgage and are desirous of having the mortgage satisfied of record to clear the title to the said property as described in the mortgage and deed as set forth above.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Petitioners pray as follows:

1. That this Court find that the mortgage recorded in Mortgage Book 1282 at Page 324 from Cecil Ray Moore and Phyllis Vivian Moore to J. Z. Rearden has been paid in full and should be satisfied of record.
2. That Donnie S. Tankersley as R.M.C. be directed to satisfy said mortgage of record.
