Located in the City of Greenville, being shown as parts of Lots 23 & 24 on a plat of Paramount Park recorded in Plat Book W page 57, and being situated on the southeastern side of 291, South Pleasantburg Drive. Said right-of-way to extend across the southern portion of said lots which is also shown as Lot 7, Block 2, Sheet M15.3 on the County Block Book.

And (we) (I) do hereby bind (ourselves) (myself), (our) (my) heirs, successors or administrators or assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the Grantee herein.
