C., the receipt whereof being hereby acknowledged, (I) (we) hereby grant unto said City of Greenville, a right-of-way or easement along, over or under (my) (our) property for the purpose of:

Constructing and maintaining a storm sewer line, including the right to install catch basins as required and/or desired by the City Engineer.

Together with the right of ingress and egress for the purpose of inspecting and maintaining the same.

Said property is described as follows: Including a strip of land 10 feet in width, lying 5 feet on each side of the centerline of the storm sewer line as finally located;

BEGINNING on the southeast side of the intersection of S. C. 291-By-Pass, Twin Lakes Road, and White Oak Road, and continuing along the east side of White Oak Road a distance of 200 feet, more or less, to a point where said storm sewer line crosses to the west side of said White ~~Oak~~ <sup>OAK</sup> Road.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the right to the City of Greenville, S. C., its successors and assigns. And (we) (I) do hereby bind (ourselves) (myself), (our) (my) heirs, successors or administrators or assigns, to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the Grantee herein.
