Greenville, South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagor, is indebted to the Administrator of Veterans' Affairs, an Officer of the United States of America, and his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, hereinafter called Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of **SIX THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY and 60/100** NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that Bobby Joe Taylor, of the County of Greenville, South Carolina, has granted, bargained, sold, assigned, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, assign, and release unto the Mortgagee, and unto his successors in such office, as such, and his or their assigns, the following described property, to-wit:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about two miles west of the City of Greenville, S. C., being known and designated as a portion of Lot No. 17 according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, May, 1947, and having the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Curtis Road, which pin is 22 1/2 feet southeast of the intersection of Curtis Road and Gordon Street; and running thence N 43-15 E 50 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of property owned by Ben William Lee and Dabney C. Carver; thence with the rear line of the property of Dabney C. Carver N 79-45 E 115 feet to an iron pin; thence S 10-15 E 154 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Curtis Road; thence with Curtis Road N 60-55 W 200 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed duly recorded in the office of the R.M.C. FOR Greenville County, South Carolina.
