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BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Tamwood Circle at the joint corner of Lots 302 and 303 and runs thence along the line of Lot 302 N. 20-22 W. 130.4 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 293 N. 72-07 E. 86.9 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 292 N. 82-03 E. 29 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot 304 S. 9-37 E. 110.5 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Tamwood Circle; thence with the curve of Tamwood Circle (the chord being S. 60-46 W. 29 feet) to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Tamwood Circle (the chord being S. 30 W. 30 feet) to an iron pin; thence continuing with Tamwood Circle S. 69-00 W. 10 feet to the beginning corner.
