POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Mary Louise Case, resident of Durham County, State of North Carolina, do hereby revoke all Powers of Attorney which I may have heretofore executed and have made, constituted and appointed and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint Kathleen Mills Exum as my true and lawful Attorney-in-Fact, to act in, manage, operate and conduct all matters relating to my property and estate, of every kind and character and wherever located, and to have in all circumstances relating to said property and estate the same powers and authority that I now possess or with which I may be subsequently endowed.

Without intending to qualify or restrict the complete and general powers hereinbefore given to my said Attorney-in-Fact, I direct that she shall have authority to sue for, collect, recover, compromise, settle and/or adjust all accounts, debts, obligations due or to become due; sell, endorse and transfer stocks, bonds, other securities and any other personal property now or hereafter in my name or belonging to me (including the power to register said assets in the name of its nominee); make and execute any and all income or other tax returns or claims for tax refund, and to pay all such taxes and receive all such refunds which may be made, paid, claimed or received by me; deposit property in and withdraw property from any safe deposit box which I may now have or hereafter belonging to me; and execute such deeds, contracts, mortgages, deeds of trust, notes or bonds as may be necessary, convenient or incident to the exercise of any authority hereinbefore given to my said Attorney-in-Fact.

This instrument is executed under and pursuant to Section 47-115.1 of the General Statutes of the State of North Carolina and shall remain in full force and effect until my death, notwithstanding any physical incapacity or mental incompetence with which I may be afflicted in the future, unless revoked by me in writing while I am still mentally capable. Any such revocation shall be registered as provided in said Section 47-115.1 of the General Statutes.
