MORTGAGE OF REAL PROPERTY

THE NOTE SECURED BY THIS MORTGAGE CONTAINS PROVISIONS FOR AN ADJUSTABLE INTEREST RATE

THIS MORTGAGE made this 31st day of March, 19 83
among W. Bruce Paterson and Margaret C. Paterson (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) and FIRST UNION MORTGAGE CORPORATION, a North Carolina corporation (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee):

WITNESSETH THAT, WHEREAS, Mortgagor is indebted to Mortgagee for money loaned for which Mortgagor has executed and delivered to Mortgagee a Note of even date herewith in the principal sum of Seven Thousand, Eight Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$ 7,800.00), with interest thereon, providing for monthly installments of principal and interest beginning on the 1st day of May, 19 83 and continuing on the 1st day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid:

AND WHEREAS, to induce the making of said loan, Mortgagor has agreed to secure said debt and interest thereon (together with any future advances) and to secure the performance of the undertakings prescribed in the Note and this Mortgage by the conveyance of the premises hereinafter described:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the aforesaid loan and the sum of Three Dollars (\$3 00) cash in hand paid to Mortgagor, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, Mortgagor hereby grants, sells, conveys, assigns and releases to Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described premises located Greenville County, South Carolina:

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being designated as Lot No. 17, of Section Two of a subdivision of the property of Blue Ridge Realty Company, Inc., known as "Fenwick Heights," the same as shown on a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1959, said plat being recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Pages 44 and 45, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Fairlawn Circle, joint front corner of Lots 17 and 18; running thence with joint line of said lots, S. 27-25 E. 156.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 65-54 W. 110.1 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 16 and 17; thence with joint line of said lots, N. 27-25 W. 149.5 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Fairlawn Circle; thence with said street, N. 62-27 E. 110 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors herein by deed of James G. Meek, Jr., dated December 15, 1981, and recorded simultaneously therewith in Deed Volume 1159 at Page 508.

This mortgage is second and junior in lien to that mortgage given in favor of Poinsett Federal Savings and Loan Association which mortgage was recorded in the RMC for Greenville County on December 16, 1981 in Mortgage Book 1559 at Page 807 in the original amount of \$36,202.24.
