This matter came to be heard before me on August 30, 1984, for a final
of Meane Conveyances of Greenville County, South Carolina, the Register
hearing on the merits pursuant to a verified Complaint and Summons filed
in the Office of the Clerk of Court on June 21, 1984. The relief sought
was for an Order directing the Register of Meane Conveyances of Greenville
County to cancel that certain mortgage filed in Book 1019, Page 175. By
Order of the Honorable C. Victor Pyle, Jr., dated June 26, 1984, this matter
was referred to me for appropriate findings and disposition. Sworn testimony
was taken in open court and based on said testimony and exhibits in this
matter which include verified pleadings and sworn affidavits, I find the
following to be the salient facts in this action:

1. Plaintiffs executed a mortgage in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Sixty (\$1,260.00) Dollars to All State Industries, later assigned to Investors Acceptance Corp., recorded in Book 1019, Page 175, R.H.C. Office of Greenville County;
2. All payments required by said mortgage were made by the Plaintiffs to the Defendant;
3. No action has been brought by the Defendant against the Plaintiffs for failure to pay mortgage payments as required;
4. Plaintiffs made a diligent effort to locate the Defendant. The Defendant ceased doing business in 1972. Service of the Summons upon the
