**Greenville Man Sentenced on DUI / Felony Driving Under The Influence, Great Bodily Injury Results**

Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor Walt Wilkins states that ANDREW JOSEPH GLASIER, age 27, pled guilty on November 5, 2014 to three counts of DUI / Felony Driving Under The Influence, Resulting in Great Bodily Injury, and to one count of DUI / Felony Driving Under The Influence Resulting in Death. GLASIER was sentenced to twenty-five years, suspended to ten years in the South Carolina Department of Corrections by the Honorable Edward M. Miller. Glasier, a Canadian citizen, was held without bond in the Greenville County Detention Center until his appearance in Court on November 5<sup>th</sup>.

The August, 2013 crash which resulted in the death of Shauntia Jackson, was investigated by the Greenville Police Department. Mrs. Jackson's three children, who were passengers in her vehicle, each sustained Great Bodily Injury. Evidence presented at the plea hearing by Assistant Solicitor Sara Lee Drawdy established that on August 12, 2013, at approximately 3:15 am, Glasier drove his Chevy Colorado pick-up truck in the wrong direction in the inbound lane of I-385 and crashed, head-on, into the Dodge Avenger sedan being driven by Mrs. Jackson. Glasier, who also sustained serious injuries in the crash. Glasier smelled of alcohol and he admitted that he had been out drinking with friends earlier that night. A blood sample taken from Glasier at the hospital was tested by the SLED Toxicology Lab and showed the defendant's blood alcohol level to be 0.199%.
