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BELTON MAN SENTENCED TO 40 YEARS FOR KILLING GREENVILLE MAN

Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor Walt Wilkins' office stated today that Robert Mondriques Jones was convicted on February 10, 2011 by a Greenville County jury of Murder, Assault and Battery with Intent to Kill, Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of a Violent Crime and Possession of a Weapon by a Person Under 18 Years of Age. The Honorable Edward W. Miller presided over the trial and sentenced the defendant to 40 years without parole.

Testimony presented at trial revealed that on March 25, 2009, the defendant left his home in Belton, SC while armed with a .38 Revolver and traveled to 410 Vardry Street. While at 410 Vardry Street, he shot and killed Vincent Antonio Campbell, Jr., and also shot his brother Kevin Devon Campbell. The defendant then fled back to Belton and disposed of the weapon. The defendant took the stand and stated that he was a gang member of the Bloods and he also admitted to the shooting. Detective David Garrison of the Greenville Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit investigated and charged the defendant with the above offenses.

The case was prosecuted by Assistant Solicitor Lucas Marchant.
