Greenville Man Sentenced on Murder and Armed Robbery Charges

Thirteenth Circuit Solicitor Walt Wilkins states that NYQUAN TYKIE BROWN, age 23, was convicted on September 5, 2019, by a Greenville County jury of murder, armed robbery, and possession of a weapon during commission of a violent crime. He was sentenced by the Honorable Edward W. Miller to 45 years in the South Carolina Department of Corrections.

Evidence presented at the trial by Assistant Solicitor Mark Moyer established that on December 8, 2016, Fred Anderson, aged 29, was shot and killed in an apartment on Shemwood Lane in the City of Greenville. Sgt. Russell Irvin of the Greenville Police Department, uncovered surveillance video that showed gunflashes in front of the apartment followed by two people running away and then entering another nearby apartment. Occupants of that apartment were later arrested for obstruction of justice before providing the identity of Nyquan Brown. Officer Tim Harrison with The Strategic Planning and Analysis Department of the Greenville Police Department used cell tower location technology to establish Nyquan Brown's presence near the crime scene at the time of the murder and to confirm his communication with the other suspects connected to the case.
