## AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE AND DIRECT THE NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A LEASE WITH THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA OF A PORTION OF COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY LOCATED AT 118 MCGEE STREET, GREENVILLE, SC 29601, CONSISTING OF A PORTION OF A BUILDING FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITY.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY GREENVILLE COUNTY COUNCIL:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Findings</u>. Greenville County owns certain real property and improvements located at 118 McGee Street, Greenville, SC 29601 (the "Property"), and the State of South Carolina (the "State") desires to lease a portion of the Property to operate a juvenile detention facility. The operation of such facility within Greenville County would serve a vital public purpose by providing necessary secure detention services for juveniles within the County, and Greenville County Council has determined that leasing a portion of the Property to the State for such purpose would be in the best interests of the citizens of Greenville County.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Authorization to Negotiate and Enter Lease</u>. The County Administrator and the Chairman of Greenville County Council are authorized and directed to negotiate and execute a lease with the State of South Carolina and/or one of its Departments of a portion of County-owned property more fully described as:

21,931 rentable square feet comprising a portion of a building located at 118 McGee Street, Greenville, SC 29601 and formerly known as the Juvenile Detention Facility.

Section 2. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
