SUBJECT:	Road Paving List (2025)

Please find attached the proposed paving list for your district for the 2025 paving season. Staff has field reviewed all of the roads on the list. Attached you will find a list and USB drive with pictures of each of the roads in your district on the list for you to review and inspect.

The roads on your lists have been chosen based primarily on their PCI (Pavement Condition Index) rating. Every four years a firm is hired to ride every county road and evaluate it using advanced scanning equipment to determine the condition of each road. They then study the data and apply a PCI rating from 1 to 100 for each road.

Historically, staff chose roads for the paving lists strictly by their PCI rating, with the lowest being first on the list. A few years ago, the decision was made to begin factoring road locations into the decision. This was done to make paving more efficient and cost effective. Now, PCI is still the primary deciding factor, but instead of looking at individual road PCIs, staff looks at the aggregate PCIs of entire subdivisions or neighborhoods/areas. This significantly decreases mobilization costs and is appreciated by the residents, as roads aren't paved piecemeal.

The overall road list will be voted on at the April 15, 2025 Roads, Infrastructure & Public Works Committee meeting and then forwarded to County Council for approval.
