GENERAL PROVISIONS FOR ON-STREET CONTAINER PERMIT

- For the purpose of this permit:
 - a. "Container" shall include, but not limited to, any dumpster, storage pod or any other container that cannot be moved under its own power which is placed wholly or partially in the public rights-of-way.
 - b. "Public Rights-of-Way" shall include, but not limited to, the roadway, sidewalks, curb & gutter, ditches, pipes, drainage structures as well as above and below ground utilities.
 - "Greenville County" shall include, but not limited to, Engineering & Maintenance Division, Roads & Bridges
 Division, Public Works Division as well as any other Agency of Greenville County.
- Greenville County shall not accept any liability for any personal injury or damage to property (public & private), nor does this permit allow any deviation from Encroachment Ordinance #3673.
- Applicant shall be liable for any personal injury or damage to property (public & private) as a result of container placement.
- Damages to Public Rights-of-Way as result of the container shall be restored to original or better condition in accordance
 with Greenville County specifications within thirty (30) days and at no cost to Greenville County.
- 5. Applicant is encouraged to take proper measures, such as planking, to prevent damage to the Public Rights-of-Way.
- Applicant is encouraged to take photographs of any pre-existing damage to the public rights-of-way prior to container placement.
- 7. Chocks shall be placed to prevent the container from rolling, sliding or tilting.
- 8. A minimum of 12 feet of usable street width shall be maintained at all times.
- Applicant shall take proper measures to ensure Container is delineated for daytime and nighttime visibility with the use of, but not limited to, reflectors, reflective tape, flashing beacons, traffic cones, barricades, etc.
- At any time, Greenville County may require removal or relocation of container due to safety hazards, special events or nuisance.
- 11. Containers shall not block driveways, to include backing movements from driveways.
- 12. Container shall not block sidewalks or any other pedestrian access.
- 13. Containers shall not be placed on streets with a speed limit over 30 mph.
- 14. Containers shall not be placed within 15 ft. of fire hydrant.
- 15. Containers shall not be placed within 30 ft. of intersection.
- 16. Container placement shall not exceed 30 days.
- 17. Containers shall be removed upon completion of work or if work ceases more than two weeks (14 days).
- 18. Containers shall legibly bear the Company Name and Phone Number of the container owner.
- 19. Copy of the Permit shall be affixed to the container so it is visible at all times and protected from the weather.
- 20. Area around dumpster shall be kept clean at all times.
- 21. In the event that the dumpster is not removed, whether by refusal of the applicant or due to not meeting any of these requirements, the County will remove and confiscate the dumpster. All expenses to confiscate the container shall be reimbursed prior to release of the container to its owner.
- 22. Failure to follow any of the above requirements may result in a \$100 fine plus \$10 /day /container until the violation is corrected or container is removed.
