## ATTENTION ALL HIGH SCHOOL JUNIORS & SENIORS

The State of South Carolina allows High School students who are sixteen and seventeen years old to assist at the polls. With proper training, students will serve as poll workers on Election Day.

Greenville County is accepting applications for additional poll workers to assist in conducting upcoming elections. This is an excellent opportunity to learn about the election process and receive payment. **IT IS A LONG DAY** (6 AM until approximately 8 PM), and the commitment is for the <u>entire day</u>, no exceptions. **You must provide for your lunch, snacks, etc. You will be required to <u>remain on site</u> the entire time.** You will learn a tremendous amount of information about our election system and work with some great people in a team environment.

Fill out the application and return it promptly. Scheduling for training classes start about 45-days prior to an election. Classes will last about three hours. You will be sent a schedule and instructions to sign up for one of the classes. Some of the duties you will perform on election day will include assisting in the setting up of a polling place location, qualifying voters, and other administrative responsibilities. <u>You must have</u> <u>transportation</u> to and from assigned polling place within a reasonable distance from home.

If (and only if) you will turn 18 on or before an election, you must register to vote <u>and</u> complete the poll **worker application form.** Return both applications to our office.
