That I, R. G. Pace in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred and no/100 in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

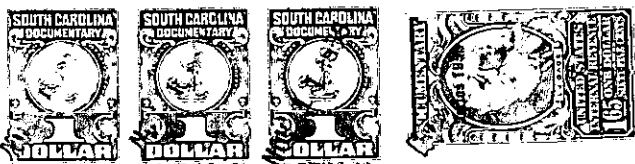

Connie Roach Barnes, her heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina known as a portion of lot 15 on plat of property of R.G.Pace made by Dalton & Neves dated July, 1953 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat book DD at page 175 and having, according to the addition by J. Mac Richardson dated June 26, 1954, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeastern side of McKinney Road, at the joint front corner of lots nos. 14 and 15 and running thence with McKinney Road, S 48 W, 80 feet to an iron pin; thence through lot 15, S 42 E, 184 feet to an iron pin in the line of lot no. 20; thence with the line of lot no. 20 N 48 E, 80 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of lots nos. 14 and 15; thence with the line of lot no. 14, N 42 W, 184 feet to the point of beginning.
