

Earnshaw Avenue and Langston Drive; thence with Earnshaw Avenue S. 52-34 E. 50 feet more or less to a point in the center of Langston Creek; thence with the creek as the line, the following traverses: N. 37-56 E. 104 feet and N. 49-26 E. 199 feet to a point where the said Langston Creek crosses the New Buncombe Road; thence along the western side of the New Buncombe Road N. 39-21 W. 56.4 feet to the point of beginning.
