run by James Kilgore reference being there unto had will more fully
appear and said twenty nine and three fourths acres including
the plantation which Benjamin Walker sold to James Redman
Together with all & the rights, members Hereditaments and appurtenan-
ces to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-
tenant to have and to hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Zachariah Smith his heirs & assigns forever
and I do hereby bind my self my heirs Executors and administrat-
ors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Zachariah Smith his heirs & assigns agai-
