interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for attorney's Three Per Cent  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note....., to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind, in which it is secured (under this mortgage); as in and by the said note....., reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. C. Cleveland

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land  
situate, lying and being in the city of Greenville  
State and County, aforesaid, fronting 60 feet on the  
East side of Atwood Street, adjoining the lot owned  
by Ward, and being directly opposite the lot given  
by me to my son John A. Williams.
