the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, and the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind, all of which are secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said D. C. Henson
