WHEREAS, John N. Wynn, the said John N. Wynn

in the full and just sum of Five hundred (\$500.00)
Dollars, to be paid 14th day of November 1920

with interest thereon from date of issue at the rate of Eight per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid in arrears

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five (10%) per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That John N. Wynn the said John N. Wynn
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. W. Norwood

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said John N. Wynn

in hand well and truly paid by the said J. W. Norwood

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. W. Norwood his heirs and assigns forever

All those three certain pieces, parcels or lots of land situate lying
and being in the state of South Carolina, and County of Greenville
on the north side of the extension of Pendleton Street in the
town of West Greenville and being known as lots # 10 11 and
12 on a plat known as Providence which plat is recorded
in Plat Book "A" at page 411 and described as follows
Beginning at a stake corner of lot # 9 on the north side
of said extension of Pendleton Street and running thence
thence N. 85 1/2 W. 80 feet to a stake thence S.
85 1/2 W. 60 feet to a stake thence S. 18 1/2 E. 80 feet to a stake
on said extension of Pendleton Street thence with said extension
of said Pendleton Street N. 85 1/2 E. 60 feet to the beginning
corner

Also all that certain other piece parcel or lot of land situate
lying and being in the state, county and Township aforesaid
on Pendleton Street Extension and being a portion of lots
13 and 14 on the plat of Providence and described as
follows: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Pendle-
ton Street extension, at corner common to lots # 12 and 13
as shown on said plat and running thence with Pendleton
Street S. 85 1/2 W. 20 feet to any iron pin at end in said
road thence with said Street N. 85 1/2 W. 11 feet to a
corner of lot east of the corner of lot # 15; thence along a
line parallel with and 9 feet distant from the east line
of lot # 15 in a northerly direction 80 feet more or less
to a stake, corner common to lots # 12 and 13; thence
with line common to lots # 12 and 13 S. 18 1/2 E. 80 feet to
the beginning corner

These being the same lots of land conveyed to me by L. A.
Greene by his deed dated July 19th 1920 and recorded in the
R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 69 Page 88.
